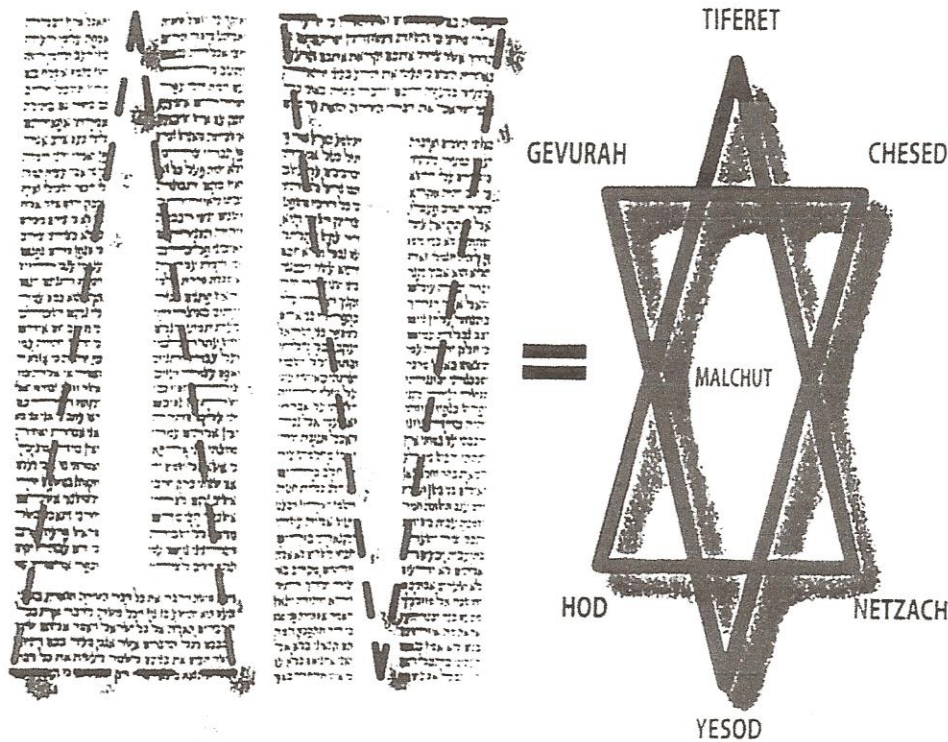


SYNOPSIS OF HA'AZINU

When you look at the Torah Scroll, the chapter of Ha'azinu is actually scribed in a very unique way. The paragraph and verses are in the shape of two triangles. These two triangles connect us to the upper six dimensions (the Sefirot of Chesed, Gevurah, Tiferet, Netzach, Hod, and Yesod) of the Tree of Life. The Zohar says that the six points of the two triangles influence and funnel the Light of the Creator to the seventh dimension of Malchut, our physical world.

The Chapter of Ha'azinu has 52 verses. According to the wisdom of Kabbalah, the number 52 relates to the physical realm of Malchut. Fifty-two is also twice the numerical value of the Tetragrammaton (Yud, Hei, Vav, Hei), $26 \times 2 = 52$, which reveals another secret. Ha'azinu shows us that our world is a mirror of the Upper Realms. If we love, we see love, if we hate, we see hate. If we do positive actions, we recognize only the positive in others.



The Star of David which is a protection shield related to the Sephirot and the Tree of Life. This protection is transferred to you from visually seeing the two columns of letters that make up the Song of HaAzinu in the scroll. It is recommended that one make that visual connection to receive this protection of the Star of David.
